# INSTRUCTIONS

THIS PLAN SEEKS TO PROVIDE A COORDINATED APPROACH TO THE MANDATORY EVACUATION OF SCARBOROUGH

Please read and familiarize yourself with the following instructions:

- 1 Remain Calm!** Identify your location on the map in the center of this bulletin.
- 2** Upon the receipt of a mandatory evacuation order, proceed on foot to the nearest Muster Point.
- 3** When you arrive at the Muster Point, be prepared to provide the Muster Steward with:- **Name, Age, Address, Tel Contact & Next of Kin.**
- 4** Persons with vehicles, are kindly asked to secure their vehicles and proceed by foot to the Muster Point that is nearest to them.

Upon instructions given by law enforcement officers, all evacuees will proceed orderly on foot to the designated muster point closest to the evacuee. A muster point is a SAFE place where everyone at risk is ordered to ASSEMBLE, whenever there is an emergency, which requires immediate evacuation away from a hazard. On the evacuation map, six muster points have been identified in green and numbered. Please identify them as follows:

1. Crusoe Bypass near the Cultural Complex and the Gas Station
2. Bishops High School recreations grounds
3. Morrison Garage car park, Wilson Road
4. Botanical Gardens lay-by on the Claude Noel Highway
5. Near Keith Louis Garage on the Claude Noel Highway
6. Old Market Car Park uptown

When the siren is sounded, the Police Service will deploy officers to the following areas as indicated by the Map *inside bulletin*.

A number of evacuation routes have been identified and established to egress Scarborough. Following the issuing of an evacuation order, all streets highlighted in green on the map, are proposed to be use as evacuation routes.

## Evacuation Routes

- The continuous blaring of the Scarborough Fire Station siren.
- SMS messages through cellular networks via the 211 Call Centre.
- Digital signs downtown through TEMA.
- Community Early Warning PA/Sirens by TEMA
- Police vehicles Public Address System.
- Mandatory Evacuation Order via Electronic Media by TEMA.

## Public Early Warning Alerts

Upon receipt of a credible threat report, an evacuation order will be issued by TEMA. The population will be alerted via the following modes of communication:-
